Thank you! I hope your holiday weekend is restful and enjoyable.

The prosecutor responded to let me know that she emailed the defense attorney stating that a decision had to be made about the plea offer by 11/30 or the State would be objecting to any further continuances at that time. This means the hearing will be on the record and you can attend in-person or by Zoom to ask the judge for permission to address the court. Unless defense wants to move forward with the offer and Plea Hearing is set, which would cause the Omnibus to be struck from the calendar.

My schedule is open at 1:00PM on Thursday, 11/30. If you plan to attend in-person at courtroom 1201 (12th floor), please let me know so I can accompany you. The logistics are a bit different and the only way to speak is to go through a locked door, it's easier if I'm there to coordinate that. If you plan to join on Zoom, then I'll observe using that method.
